## **Robert M. Duerr Jr. Scholarship Notre Dame Academy**

Robert M. Duerr, Jr. was born and raised in Green Bay. The son of Robert, Sr. and Marjorie Duerr, Bob attended Annunciation Catholic School and graduated from Our Lady of Premontre High School in 1959.

Bob worked for more than 25 years at Paper Converting in Green Bay. He was actively involved in the support of athletics in Green Bay and was President of the Green Bay Blue Ribbons. He generously supported the Green Bay Blue Ribbons, as well as the needy families in the community.

Bob died on October 12, 1988. His generous support of youth was expressed prior to his death with the establishment of a significant scholarship fund for the students of his Catholic high school, Premontre High School, which is now Notre Dame Academy. In his own words, these scholarship monies are to help students benefit from the educational environment of a Catholic secondary school environment.

Notre Dame Academy is pleased to announce the continuation of the Robert M. Duerr, Jr. Scholarship for the next academic year. Full and partial scholarships may be granted to male and female students on a one, two, three, or four-year basis. Incoming freshmen may apply if they meet the following criteria:
