## CURRICULUM

NDA offers a college preparatory curriculum to all students. In addition, accelerated, advanced, college credit and International Baccalaureate (IB) courses are offered. The academic year consists of two semesters of the following standard course loads:

- Freshman Junior Level: Seven courses + one study hall
- Senior Level: Six courses + one study hall

Students may request to take additional courses beyond the standard course load.

#### INTERNATIONAL BACCALAUREATE PROGRAMME

The IB program is an optional two-year rigorous learning program during junior and senior years. Classes are offered in six academic areas: Primary Language, Second Language, Mathematics, Science, Individuals and Society, and the Arts. Based on scores, examinations, and completion of IB requirements, students may receive an IB Diploma.

#### **DUAL CREDIT - COLLEGE CREDIT PROGRAM**

Through our partnerships with St. Norbert College, Northeast Wisconsin Technical College, and University of Wisconsin Green Bay, NDA offers students the opportunity to take dual credit courses to gain college credit. Students and families must consult college websites/admissions for credit transfer specifics. Additionally, students may gain college credit and/or advanced standing through one or more of the 38 Advanced Placement (AP) exams offered at NDA.

## HONORS PROGRAM

Honors classes are offered in English, Mathematics, Science and World Languages. Admission to accelerated classes, which include classes designated as "honors" or "advanced," is determined by placement exams, teacher recommendations, past performance and/or discussion with students and parents/guardians.

## NDA COVID-19 GRADING POLICY CHANGE (BEGINNING MARCH 2020):

Students are able to petition for course grade(s) to be PASS/FAIL (P/F) in extenuating circumstances beyond their control due to the COVID-19 pandemic. Families are required to work with the teacher, Student Services, and the Principal to complete this process.

#### GRADING

GPA is calculated on a 4-point grading scale at the end of each semester. All Honors and IB classes are weighted.

NDA uses an adjusted grading scale (AGS) for a small portion of students who have diagnosed conditions that make learning difficult. In these instances, the D-range is 60-71%. Less than 5% of our student population utilized the AGS in 2020-21.
