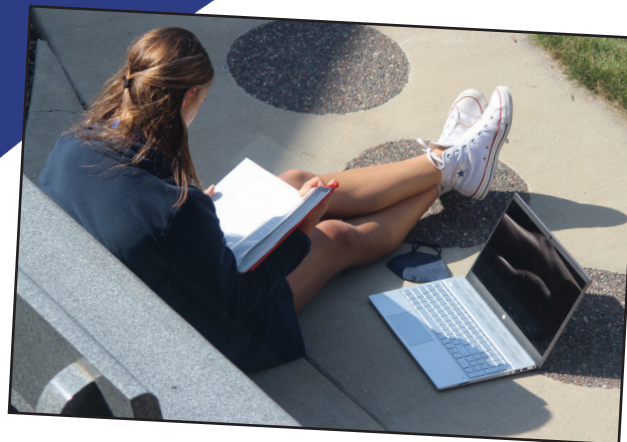

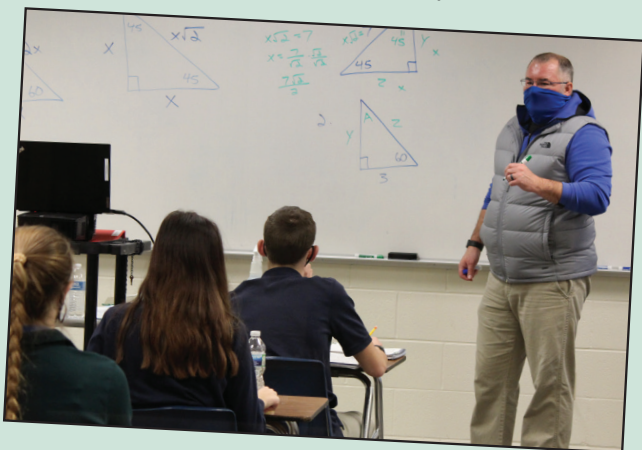

Course Offerings

Students will earn 1/2 credit for each course.

- **Algebra I and II (morning session)**
 - These algebra courses are designed to strengthen each student's mathematical skills. Students will receive individual attention according to individual needs and skill levels.
- **Team & Strategic Games (morning session)**
 - This course will meet the semester requirement for Physical Education. A variety of team activities will include basketball, volleyball, tennis, whiffle ball, badminton, soccer, and track & field.
- **Lifetime Fitness (afternoon session)**
 - This course is a continuation of skills and activities from Team & Strategic Games (prerequisite). New activities will be introduced, as well.
- **Computer Applications (afternoon session)**

-This is a hybrid course, which meets only on Mondays in person. Modules and communication with the instructor are completed online throughout the rest of the week.

-Project-based applications reinforce various computer applications including, but not limited to: document formats, spreadsheets, website creation, various presentational web-based platforms, and workforce/educational skills. New ways to present material beyond the slides will be emphasized. Google Suites will be used due to its online format, but some Office Applications will be used during in-class meeting times.

-Cyber safety, digital citizenship, and information fluency are explored.

-Student must be able to self pace, complete items on time, communicate well, and have consistent access to the internet in order to be successful in this class.

Course Grades

- Students will receive 1/2 credit for the successful completion of each for-credit summer school course.
- Credits apply toward graduation requirements.
- Grades will be factored into GPA.
- If a student is repeating a course, credit will only be given if the student has previously received a grade lower than a C-, and the GPA will be recalculated.

Attendance

- Daily attendance is taken.
- The COVID-19 Assessment in the Magnus Health app will have to be completed by a parent/guardian before entering the school.
- If a student misses more than two days, he/she will be dropped from the course.
- All absences must be reported by a parent at (920) 429-6191.

Dress Code

- Due to COVID-19, a mask must be worn inside the school building.
- Casual dress. Clean and respectful, consistent with the core values of NDA.
- Physical Education classes will inform students of appropriate dress on first day.
