



Protocols for Home Boys Soccer games

Notre Dame Academy is very excited for the Fall Sports seasons. With the current COVID-19 pandemic, we continue to work diligently to create protocols for all of our events. Here are some guidelines that will be in place for the Boys Soccer 2020 Fall sports season in regards to spectators:

For NDA Parents

- For all Fall boys soccer games we will limit 2 spectators per athlete at home events. This is for all levels (JV, and Varsity). These 2 spectators must be direct family members of a participant (parents, guardians, sibling, grandparent).
- Each week or before each game, parents of the players will receive a google form link from the athletic department in which you will have to go in to reserve your place at the game. You will enter your athlete's name, and the family members attending. This must be completed before 3 p.m. on game day
- NDA parents will be asked to sit on the hill at Ted Fritsch Stadium, opposite the press box. Parents will be allowed to bring in lawn chairs and blankets for seating
- Gates will be open for entrance 30 minutes before the game starts, and will close 30 minutes after the kickoff. There will be no exiting and re-entering the facility this year. JV Parents, we kindly ask you to depart the facility upon the completion of the game
- NDA parents will be asked to park in the student lot. They will enter the gate(ticket booth) closest to the baseball field.

For visiting teams

- 2 Spectators will be permitted per athlete. These 2 spectators must be direct family members of a participant (parents, guardians, sibling, grandparent).
- The AD of visiting teams will receive a google form before each game and the parents will need to sign these before 3pm on the day of a game.
- Visiting parents will be sitting in the bleachers. They will be asked to park on Locust street behind the bleachers, enter the gate at the concession stand and exit the stadium at the concession stand gate or the gate behind the press box.
- Gates will be open for entrance 30 minutes before the game starts, and will close 30 minutes after the kickoff. There will be no exiting and re-entering the facility this year.

For both NDA and Visiting Teams

- The home team bench will be located on the hill side of the facility and the Visitors bench will be located on the bleacher side. Extra chairs will be put out and we ask that players on the bench stay 6 feet apart and utilize the benches and chairs.
- For multiple games on the same day, but at different times we will ask that the spectators leave once their student(s) level is complete. So JV spectators will be asked to leave before the Varsity competition and Varsity spectators will be asked to wait until JV is completed before entering the venue.
- Concessions will not be served at any home event for NDA. This is to limit a gathering spot and other potential risks.
- All spectators should perform a self-screening check for COVID-19 related symptoms or possible close contacts prior to coming to any school event.
- All spectators (both inside and outside) will be required to wear a face covering while at events at Notre Dame Academy and will be required to be socially distant (6 feet or more) from anyone not in their household. We ask that if anyone has symptoms or feel sick that they remain home.
- There will be no cost for admission at Fall Sports for 2020. However, in order to be permitted, you must be signed in through the google forms link sent to the parents and visiting schools administration.
- For any away event, parents and spectators will be required to follow any additional procedures in place for that school.
- More information will come with how and what you will receive as a “ticket” to events if one is needed.
